1. Approval of minutes from February 9, 2010 meeting – Dr. Brown

2. HEB proposed course changes – Dr. Sadie Sanders

HSC 4593 HIV/AIDS Education

Old Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors, junior or senior standing, HSC 3032 with a grade of C or better; non-majors must have junior or senior standing.

New Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors; junior or senior standing

Justification: Department would like to open the course to non-HEB students after advanced registration has concluded.

HSC 4624 Trends in International Health

Old Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors, junior or senior standing, HSC 3032 with a grade of C or better; non-majors must have junior or senior standing.

New Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors; junior or senior standing

Justification: Department would like to open the course to non-HEB students after advanced registration has concluded.

HSC 4663 Community Health Methods in Injury Prevention and Control

Old Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors, junior or senior standing, HSC 3032 with a grade of C or better

New Pre-requisite: HH-HEB majors; junior or senior standing

Justification: Department would like to open the course to non-HEB students after advanced registration has concluded.

Committee noted discrepancy between old pre-requisites listed on the memo and on the UCC 2 forms. What is noted above is correct and change will be made prior to submitting to the University Curriculum Committee.

3. HEB proposed course change – Dr. Virginia Dodd

PHC 6105 Organization and Administration of Public Health Programs

New Course Title: Health Promotion Policy and Practice

Justification: The course was originally taught as part of the interdepartmental MPH program. When the MPH program was removed in its entirety to the College of Public Health and Health Professions the title of the course and its seeming focus on public health programs was not perceived by HEB as relevant to their future professional needs. While the course content will remain the same, the new course title will better represent the department in which the course is currently offered.

Committee inquired if the College of Public Health and Health Professions had been contacted. The response was that PHHP has consented to the name change.

Committee inquired as to the possible necessity of creating a new course versus submitting a course change. It was stated that the course content was not changing; therefore the preference was to leave the course under the existing course number.

Committee requested that a new syllabus be provided to accompany the UCC2 form. This will be submitted by Dr. Dodd by May 1, 2010.

Motion to approve by Dr. Williams, seconded by Dr. Janelle, motion passed. Items will be forwarded to the Graduate Curriculum Committee for the next agenda.

4. Other Items – Dr. Kelli Brown

The committee was asked to provide their philosophy regarding the College policy requiring native students to complete universal tracking/critical tracking courses at UF versus as a transient student elsewhere. The consensus was that this is an appropriate requirement and that as long as petitions are accepted, the policy should be maintained.
