My primary research interest is sport consumer behavior, especially in sport media context. With the development of the Internet, consumers are exposed to vast amount of information and advertisements through social media rather than through traditional media. Therefore, research on consumer behavior related to sports content on social media channels are crucial for marketers and content creators for them to better understand their consumers who are heavily influenced by social media content daily. In line with this trend, I would like to provide practical implications to social media content creators by analyzing factors that are considered significant in sport-related content in social media by revealing consumers' socio-psychological process of consuming content. Currently, my research is being conducted in the YouTube context, focusing on the concept of perceived authenticity. Several studies revealed that authenticity is an important and significant factor in marketing as the advent of the information age leads to the wide exposure and trust of false information by the public. Therefore, I would like to expand my current research to cover the diverse social media channels (e.g., Instagram, Facebook). Moreover, based on strong theory and new concepts, I will further investigate the factors that make sport-related social media content and advertisement more influential and impactful. However, as my main research interest is sport consumer behavior, I will not limit my research in social media context. Rather, I also plan on researching on consumer behaviors in diverse contexts such as sport merchandise purchase decisions as my current research is on the effect of self-presentation on brand conspicuousness preference.
