As an Economic Empowerment Intern you will work directly with survivors and teach them the skills and tools they need for LIFE (Live Independent and Financially Empowered) away from an abusive partner. This position is unpaid.

#### Qualifications

- Pursuing a 4-year degree at an accredited university
- 3.0 GPA minimum
- Preferred majors include: Business Administration, Finance, Economics, Political Science, Communications, Marketing, Education, Non-profit Management, Public Administration, or other related fields
- Excellent written and oral communication skills, independent, and self-motivated
- Flexible schedule between 15-20 hours per week (Monday-Friday 9 a.m. 5 p.m. some evening and Saturday Events), and reliable transportation. **Must be able to commit to 2 semesters**.

## **Intern Responsibilities**

- Work closely with the Economic Empowerment coordinator to re-organize and further develop the microloan program.
- Assist in the loan process from beginning to end including processing loan applications, setting up account
  files, consulting on loan projects, and following up with clients regarding their progress and required
  emergency savings account.
- Utilize software to help in the credit reporting process, scheduling payments, and adjusting billing invoices.
- Collaborate on designing financial literacy curriculum, in addition to teaching workshops and financial literacy classes to domestic abuse survivors.
