All interns are required to complete a BHSF internship packet. They need to show proof of vaccinations (measles, mumps, rubella, varicella), a PPD within 12 months and influenza vaccination (if internship is between October - April).

All interns must send us a current resume, have an interview with the intern supervisor and then a panel interview with staff to determine best fit, and that internship requirements can be met.

Interns first shadow the wellness coaches at their entity so they can understand the BHSF culture and the culture of Wellness Advantage. They will assist with the creation, implementation and evaluation of a program or project.
